The Ground Jury has the authority to make decisions either alone or together on Event Days.

The Ground Jury has the authority to ask riders with excessively unruly horses to dismount for the safety of other competitors.

SAFTEY GUIDELINES:

Grounds:

Grounds will be inspected before and during arena preparations any debris will be removed.

Arenas:

Arenas will be inspected by the Judge before commencement of competition. All care will be offered but TVEG INC WILL NOT BE HELD RESPONSIBLE.

TVEG INC has purchased free standing arenas that comply with the current EA Queensland standards.

Riders:

Protective headgear must conform with one of the current approved safety standards outlined below, The EA General Regulations at rule 122.2 prescribe the current standards.

It is the responsibility of the rider to ensure they are using a current standard safety helmet.

- Current Australian standard AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards) provided they are SAI Global marked.
- New Australian standard ARB HS 2012 provided they are SAI Global marked.
- Current American standards ASTM F1163 (2004a or 04a onwards) provided they are SEI marked, or SNELL E2001.
- Current British standard PAS 015 (1998 or 2011) provided they are BSI Kitemarked.
- Interim European Standard VG1 (01.040: 2014-12) with or without BSI Kitemark.

 Outgoing European Standard EN/1384 during 2016 only – not permitted from 2017

It is the riders responsibility that all equipment used in competition is in good working order.

Horse Health Declarations must be handed in before competing

Dogs:

Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times and under NO circumstances be allowed in the competition and warm up areas.

Spectators:

Must not enter Competitors parking area/warm up area.

Must not enter Competition area without Event Organizer's Permission

Must be a minimum of 20 metres away from arenas.

Video Cameras:

Must be a minimum of 20 meters away from arenas.

Insurance:

TWEED VALLEY EQUESTRIAN INC, is a current member of EFA QUEENSLAND.

Murwillumbah Show Ground Trust, and the Minister for Crown Lands are indemnified against any and all claims.

Incidents:

In the event of an accident to either rider, horse or spectator, a record will be made of the incident in the Incident Book recording date, time, name, location of incident, details of incident, witnesses to the incident, and this will be signed by the relevant parties involved.

A copy of this form will be forwarded to TVEG Inc committee and to EFA Queensland within 7 days of the event.
