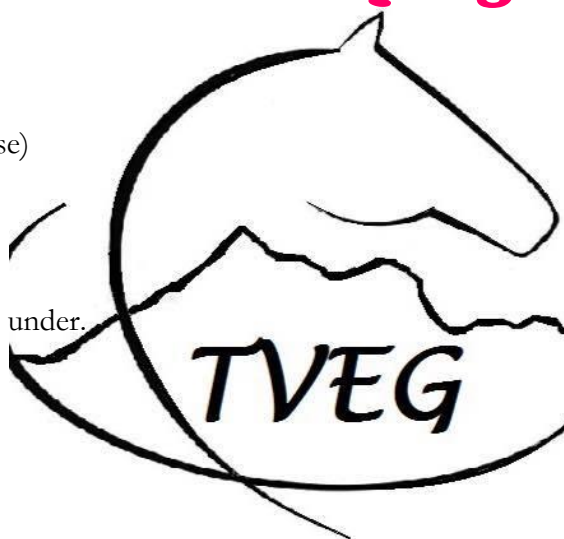
Saturday 10th October Start 9:00am

TVEG will be following all COVID-19 safety and precautions as directed by NSW Health & EQ as they become available. Riders who have been unwell, or have been in Victoria in the 14 days prior or to any of the hotspots listed on the NSW Health site must not attend

Conditions of Entry Show jumping: Dress: Smart Casual, collared shirts (Pink preferred!), regulation helmet and boots. Each horse may only be entered in a maximum of three rounds per day. Only Riders issued with a coloured wrist band to enter the ring after filling in indemnity form and horse health declaration. Riders must present their current EA membership card or pay the TVEG membership fee. Open to all riders, you must be EA registered or TVEG member. TVEG Day membership available \$20 per Day. Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times. Riders/owners must be present to collect prizes/ribbons. Stallions must wear official 'green discs' at all times whilst at the venue. These discs are to be worn on both sides of head collars and bridles or on some part of the horse on both sides to identify to others that the horse is a stallion. Stables are \$15 per day.
