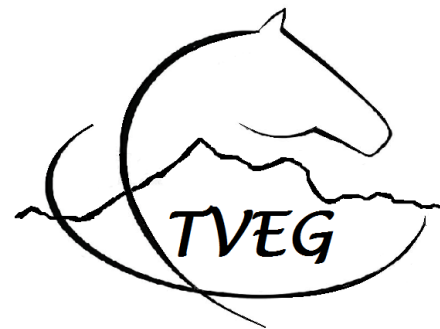

Champion Prizes in each level *****COVID SAFE EVENT

Prizes will be awarded for the following: *Best Dressed Horse and Rider-“Pretty in Pink” *Pinkest Horse *Pinkest Rider

Champions are awarded over two classes at the same level, Sunday's Champions from Junior and Senior classes, Saturday's Champions from Official classes.

Conditions of Entry

- * **Prep classes** are for horse and rider combinations who have not won 3 tests at this level, 2013 tests.
- Freestyle tests must state what level is being ridden in entry notes, maximum time 5 mins
- +Juniors are under 17yoa.
- EA & FEI rules apply as of 1st January 2019, including current helmet regulations.
- Horses may compete in 2 consecutive levels and no more than 3 tests may be ridden on any single day, riders may ride 2 horses.
- Horses/ponies may have more than one rider but no more than 3 tests per horse/pony- Sunday classes only.
- Stables/camping Bookings and payment must be made with entries
- Riders must present to gear check before each test or will incur elimination
- Riders must arrange their own callers. Jackets are optional
- Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times and kept at vehicles
- **No Spectators in the main arena**

- In the event of cancellation or withdrawal (Dr's or vet certificate required) the organising committee will retain 20% of entry fees.
- No equal places will be awarded.
- No horse can compete below its EA graded level except HC
- **THERE IS NO LUNGING IN THE MAIN ARENA**
- Neither the organizing committee of any competition to which these rules apply, nor the EA accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, grooms, spectators or any person or property whatsoever.
- HELMET REGULATIONS as of 1/1/17
- EA current Concussion Protocol will be imposed.
- TVEG will be following current Australian Federal and State judicial and Sport authorities COVID-19 guidelines by: practising good hygiene, physical distancing, following the limits for public gatherings and understand how to isolate if you need to. If you are or have experienced any of the following, it is your responsibility to declare to OC designated COVID safety officer if:
 - your health or wellbeing is compromised and you are experiencing: flu-like symptoms, sore throat, loss of taste or smell, cough, shortness of breath or high temperature.
- you have been in contact with an unwell person in the past 14 days • Stay at home and do not attend the equestrian training or competition activity. If you become unwell following attendance at an equestrian training or competition activity it is your responsibility to:
