## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- › Prep classes: for horse & rider combinations who have NOT won 3 tests at this level or placed in Preliminary level (2023 tests)
- › Juniors are 17 years old and under (+JNR)
- › The event will be run under current EA and/or FEI rules, including updated dressage rules from 1st January 2026
- › Helmet tagging is mandatory
- › EA 4.8.5: Horse Identification number and Green Stallion Disk required
- › Horses may compete in 2 consecutive levels; no more than 3 tests ridden on any single day; riders may ride 3 horses
- › EA Concussion Protocol will be in place — see EA guidelines
- › Current 2023 dressage tests apply
- › Stables/camping bookings and payment must be made with entries
- › Riders must arrange their own callers — No Spectators in the main arena
- › Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times and away from canteen/results area
- › QLD competitors: organise tick spraying before arrival — contact the Department of Primary Industries (spraying available at Currumbin or Beenleigh)
- › In the event of cancellation or withdrawal (Dr's or vet certificate required), the organising committee will retain 20% of entry fees
- › No equal places will be awarded
- › **THERE IS NO LUNGING IN THE MAIN ARENA**
- › No horse can compete below its EA graded level, except HC
- › **If 5 riders or fewer in a class, only first prize money awarded**
- › **Ribbons and Prize giving will take place after arena pack down — riders must be present to claim prizes**
- › Neither the organising committee nor EA accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, grooms, spectators or any person or property
